

How to mount a Signup graphic panel

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL BE NEEDED TO SET-UP YOUR NEW SIGNUP.

DENATURATED ALCOHOL



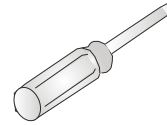
CLOTH TOWEL



NEW HANDLE WITH HOOK,
BOTTOM HANDLE WITH SLOT
& 2 MOUNTING STRIPS



PHILLIPS SCREWDRIVER

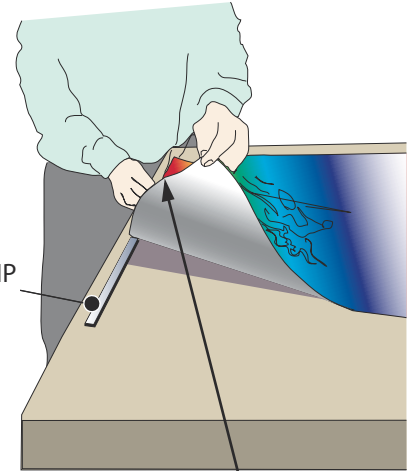


GRAPHIC PANEL

1 Graphic Panel Preparation

Apply denatured alcohol to a clean cloth and wipe the back side of the graphic. On the mounting strip, peel off the covering on the adhesive and mount the strip to the top backside of the graphic.



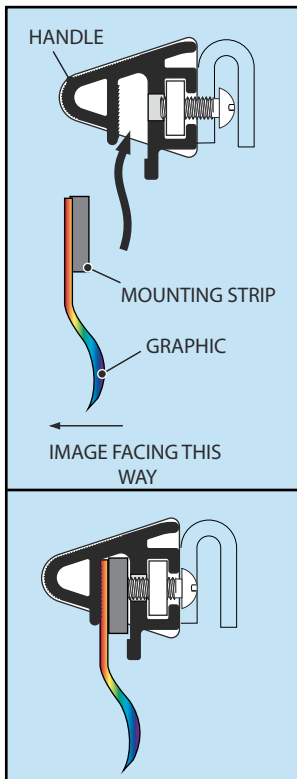
MOUNTING STRIP

2 Graphic Panel Mounting

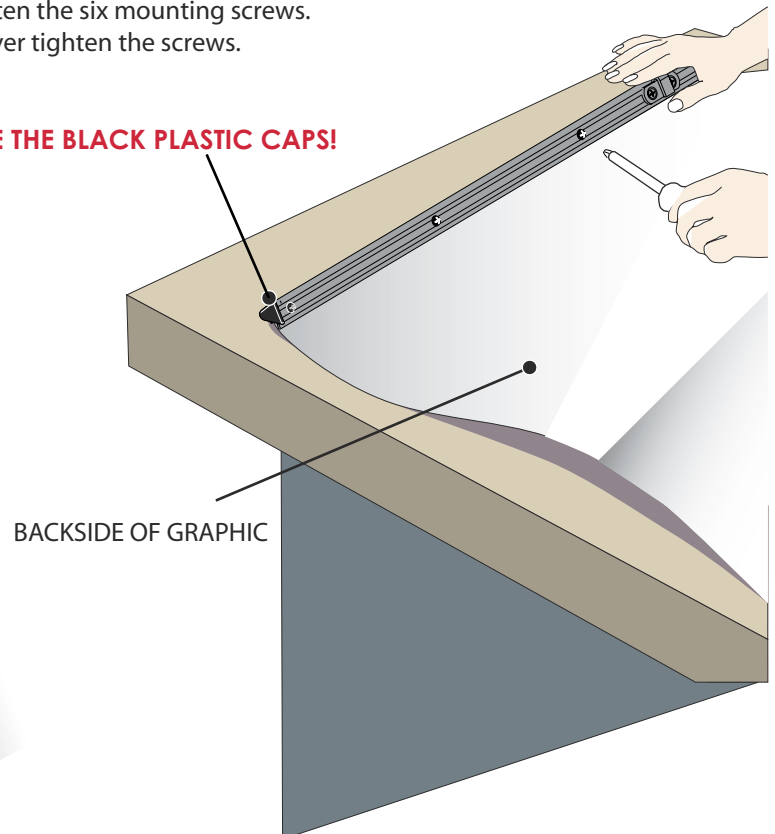
Slip the mounting strip & graphic into the clamping channel in the handle. (See DIAGRAM 1)

DIAGRAM 1



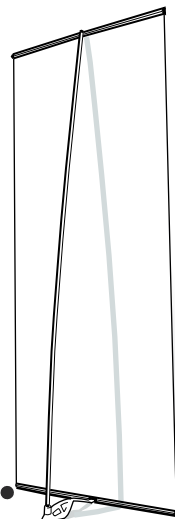
While holding the graphic panel into the handle slot, tighten the six mounting screws. Be sure not to over tighten the screws.

DO NOT REMOVE THE BLACK PLASTIC CAPS!



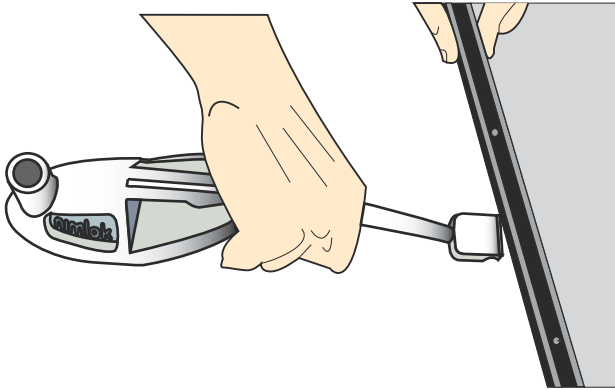
BACKSIDE OF GRAPHIC

Repeat these steps for the bottom slotted handle.

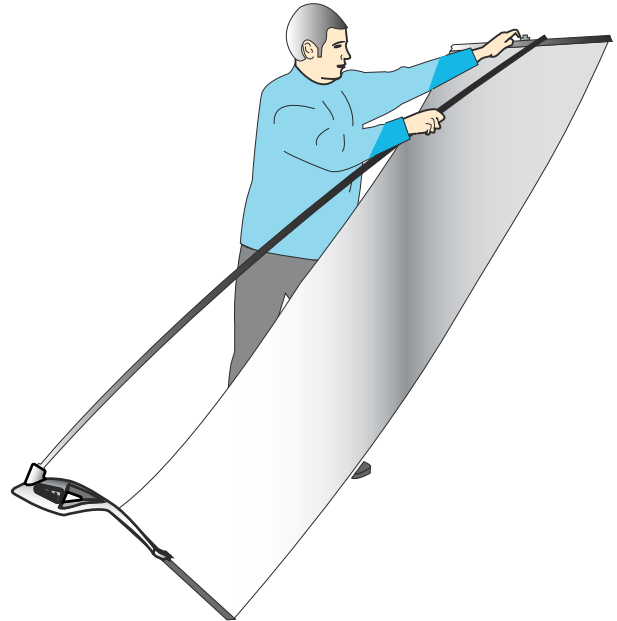


3 Setting up the Signup

Insert foot into slot on bottom handle and slide foot to center of handle.



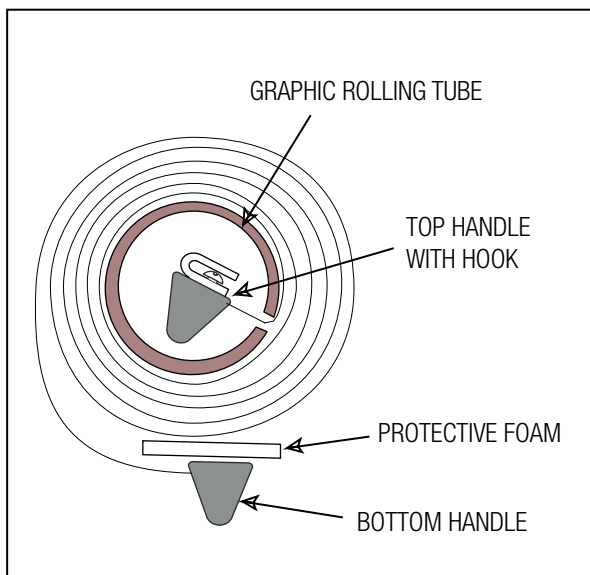
Insert pole into foot, then hook top handle into top of pole.



4 Packing

Slide C-shaped tube over handle with hook, then roll graphic on outside of tube keeping the graphic to the outside.

A protective foam layer should be added between the bottom handle and graphic when using a graphic that is sensitive to scratching.



Place graphic roll into carrying case, then add nylon bag with foot and poles in bag.
